### Thought for the Day

The word "Rosary" means "Crown of Roses". Each time you say a "Hail Mary" imagine you are giving Our Lady a beautiful rose! St. Louis de Montfort tells the story of a Jesuit brother, Alphonsus Rodriguez, who used to say his Rosary with such fervour that observers often saw a red rose come out of his mouth at each Our Father, and a white rose at each Hail Mary.

One day Saint Gertrude the Great had a vision of our Lord counting gold coins. She summoned the courage to ask Him what he was doing, and he answered, "I am counting the Hail Marys that you have said; this is the money with which you purchase Heaven."

This is what Our Lady herself said to Saint Gertrude: "Never has any man composed anything more beautiful than the Hail Mary. No salutation could be dearer to my heart than those beautiful and dignified words that God the Father addressed to me Himself."

## AND THE WINDERMERE CHURCH ROOF ....

A big thank you to everyone who has already generously donated towards our fundraising campaign. Thanks to you, the amount now raised has grown to a few pounds short of **£5000**. We are designating special Masses for the intentions of our benefactors throughout the year.

We still have a large amount to raise (£120 - £150k) to repair and replace all areas of the Church roofs and the gutters, this includes the Church Hall, which serves the Catholic School daily, for their activities and lunch. **Look out for news of some fundraising activities in the run up to Christmas. We'll be calling all gardeners, cake bakers, and looking for other contributors too!**

Our Church was built in 1962 and while the roofs have served us well up to now, they are showing wear and tear on the pitched roofs and the flat roofs, of which there are six, are failing dramatically.

### What you can do ...

**Firstly**, Pray for us. Ask Our Lord to help us repair His House, our sanctuary of the Holy Eucharist and a meeting place for His people in Windermere.
