The parishes of Ambleside and Windermere are both in urgent need of more help. The people who are currently volunteering are overloaded!

Below is the list of tasks where a need has been identified right now. But, if you feel you have talents that you could bring to our church community, please feel free to offer your help in any area that interests you.

Some jobs are occasional, some requiring only a few hours per month, and some can be done remotely. The more people we have to spread the load means that the workload will be lighter for everyone.

Windermere

1. An additional CAFOD representative (appeals are generally just twice a year)

2. Co-editor for the newsletter (this job can be done from your home)
3. Help setting up and clearing the altar for weekend and weekday Masses
4. Flower Rota. This could be as a flower arranger or as someone who clears away old flowers and washes vases etc.
5. Singing/musician volunteers for major feasts e.g. Christmas /Easter etc.
6. Help removing candle wax from the altar carpet
7. Assisting with thorough church cleaning prior to Easter and Christmas. The more people we can get for this, the smaller the time commitment for everyone. The Easter list is currently in the porch.
8. Tidying the pews after weekend Masses.

1. Sacristan
2. Counting and banking collection monies
3. All rota duties: Flowers, cleaning, greeters, tea & coffee after Mass

Sign-up sheets will be available in the Sacristies of both churches. You can also speak to Father Ajish to let him know of your interest.

AND BACK TO THE WINDERMERE CHURCH ROOF

Thanks to all the fundraising efforts we have now raised just **over £12,426** - an amazing amount!! Check out the Fund Thermometer in the church entrance to see how far we have got, and how far we have to go to reach our target of £120k.

Our Church was built in 1962 and while the roofs have served us well up to now, they are showing wear and tear and the flat roofs, of which there are six, are failing dramatically. This year, 2024, is the Jubilee Year of the church. Wouldn't it be great to use this anniversary to secure our House of God until the next Jubilee? With your help, we can do it!
